



On Thursday, April 20, 2017, the Housing Authority of the County of Los Angeles (HACoLA) will host a Resource Fair from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at its Alhambra Main Office, located at 700 W. Main Street, Alhambra, CA, to commemorate the anniversary of the passing of the Fair Housing Act.

This year's theme, ***Fair Housing Equals Opportunity***, will highlight equality in housing as a foundation upon which aspirations can be achieved, as well as affirming the Fair Housing Act's ongoing role in confronting housing discrimination. Fundamentally, fair housing means that every person can live free. This means that our communities are open, welcoming, and free from housing discrimination and hostility.

In support of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's mission to enhance the public's awareness of their fair housing rights and promoting the nation's commitment to end housing discrimination, HACoLA's Resource Fair will provide clients and the public with information regarding Fair Housing. Information will also be available on other HACoLA Programs such as the Family Self-Sufficiency program, Landlord Veteran Incentive Program, and the Homeless Incentive Program.

Local agencies, such as the Department of Consumer Affairs and the Fair Housing Foundation will be available to provide information about the array of services available to County residents, and answer questions about consumer rights.
